General Interest

The Foreign Ministry does general knowledge and especially our fellow citizens, that the regulation of Decree 263-2011 ACTS consular services and consular protection, instructs consular officials accredited in all consular posts where the Government of Honduras is represented, to ensure consular protection services, without delay, at any time, at no cost and regardless of immigration status that is any Honduran citizen.

To this end, consular protection services that by law consular officers are required to provide, are:

- a. Repatriation of deceased Hondurans.
- b. Repatriation of Hondurans sick gravity conditions, injured or maimed.
- c. Honduran victims of trafficking in persons.
- d. Adults and children in vulnerable conditions.
- e. Honduran calamity conditions duly established.
- f. Honduran immigration detainees and conditions in deportation proceedings.
- g. Honduran criminal suspects accompanied the judicial process.
- h. Special assistance to Honduras in whose cases the prosecution has sought the death penalty or life imprisonment and are already sentenced to such penalties.
- Processes forced adoption of children.
- j. Human rights violations.
- k. Visits to immigration detention centers and prisons where they are held Hondurans.
